<u>Andalusia</u>	<u>Lake District</u>
Andalusia is a Southern Region of Spain. Spain is in Europe. It has a Mediterranean climate.	The Lake District is in Cumbria in the North West of England. England is in Europe. It has a temperate climate.
Andalusia's largest mountain range is the Sierra Nevada. It has a rocky terrain. The Tabernas Desert is the only desert in Europe. The major rivers are Guadalquivir and Guadiana. Lake Iznajar is the largest river in Andalusia. Andalusia has clear seas with golden sandy beaches.	The largest mountain in the Lake District is Scafell Pike. It has a rocky peak and grassy mountain sides. The Lake District does not have any deserts. The River Kent is one of the longest rivers in the Lake District. Windermere is the largest body of water in the Lake District. The Lake District Coast is a mixture of sandstone cliffs, dunes and wide silt filled estuaries.
Many tourists visit Andalusia for its beaches and hot weather. Andalusia largely grows crops such as olives, avocados and citrus fruit. The major settlements in Andalusia are Seville, Granada and Cordoba.	Many tourists visit the Lake District for hiking, outdoor activities and the views. Farming in the Lake District is largely characterised by sheep and beef production. The largest settlements in the Lake District are Kendal, Ambleside and Windermere.
