



Key Facts

- The most visible mark that humanity has left on the planet is the transformation of wild habitats into farmland.
- Almost half (44%) of the world's habitable land is used for agriculture.
- We use a lot of land to grow crops for biofuels and other industrial products, and an even bigger share is used to feed livestock
