Thank you to all our families who are working hard to ensure our children attend school as regularly as possible and maintain good attendance and punctuality. We monitor pupil attendance which falls below 90% with our Education Welfare Officer.

It is also important that your child arrives on time. After half term, we will be monitoring this closely.


Any pupil arriving after 9am will be recorded as late.




### SUPPORTING YOU ALWAYS

## Certificate of Accreditation for National Online Safety


