Activity 1 - Collecting and recording data

For each day Monday to Friday. Record the weather using the following structure.

Activity 2 - Measuring rainfall

It is meant to rain this week. We are going to measure the amount of rain that falls.

You will need to make a rain gauge first.

You will need:

a glass jar or large plastic bottle (with the top cut off-see photos)

a pen

a place outside on the ground or a windowsill

Method: use a ruler to measure out centimetres up the side of the bottle. Use the pen to mark it on. Make sure 1cm is at the bottom of the glass/jar.



Each day Monday to Friday, measure how much rainfall is collected in your rain gauge and make a note of it.

		<p>Things to remember: measure and empty your rain gauge at the same time each day. You only need to measure it once every 24 hours.</p>
