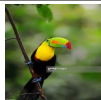
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**Spellings and Times Tables:** Given on Friday for a test on the following Friday.

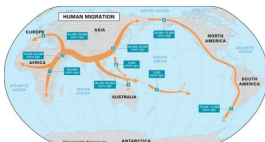


### What are we learning?

### What are we learning?



Vikings (Lady of the Mercians)

- To order key events on a timeline.
- To understand where the Vikings came from.
- To understand how and why the Vikings invaded Britain.
- To understand how some kings in Britain dealt with the Viking invaders.
- To learn about the features of a Viking Long ship.
- To understand the importance of Lindisfarne to the Vikings.
- To learn story of King Alfred and his struggles against the Vikings.
- To explain how the Danelaw came about.

- To analyse and comment on the methods and approach used by Peter Thorpe in his space themed artwork.
- To use blending techniques to achieve a 3D effect in objects.
- To develop tone, tint and shade by layering colours with pastels.
- To experiment with wet media.

- To create a piece of artwork in the style of Peter Thorpe.

### Ideas to support your child

Why not visit the Science Museum to explore space from rockets to satellites, probes to landers, their gallery showcases some out-of-this world objects.

We are learning about the abstract artist Peter Thorpe, have a go at create your own abstract rocket picture or take a trip to an art gallery to view some of the wonderful creations on display.

Ask your child lots of questions about what they are learning about the Vikings and allow them to visit your local library to choose books related to the topic. The British Museum also has an interactive exhibition for kids with active imaginations, as practically every aspect of Viking history and their relics are explored.

## ENGLISH

### What are we learning?

Our Focus text this term will be **Belonging & Equality - The Lost thing**

We will also look at **Poetry: Haiku Poetry (traditional Japanese poetic art consisting of 3 lines)**

We will study a range of them perform the haikus, which will help children to consider and convey the meaning of the poems. Children will do plenty of work on looking at the syllables in these poems. (A good activity to support this is for children to clap their hands on each syllable as they read.)

In the process of writing a haiku, children will be given a subject to write about and asked to brainstorm this, by writing several different

ideas on a spider diagram. Children will go on to write and perform their own.
