Please could parents and carers ensure that children **do not** swing or pull on the willow trees at the front of the school.

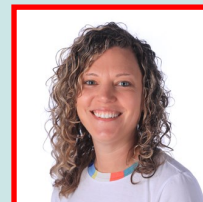
As you can see from this photo a section has been pulled to the point that it is now destroyed.

We would appreciate your support in teaching the children to be respectful of their environment and all living things.



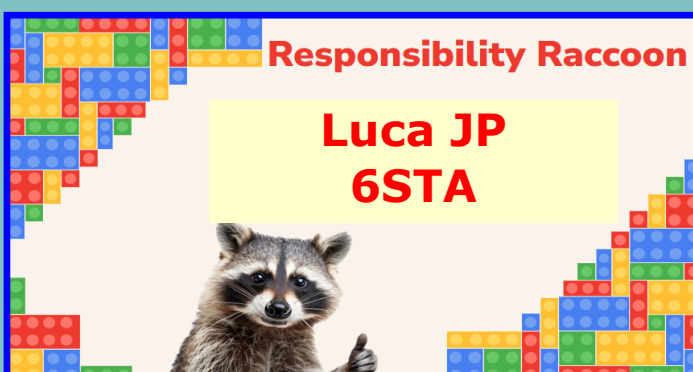
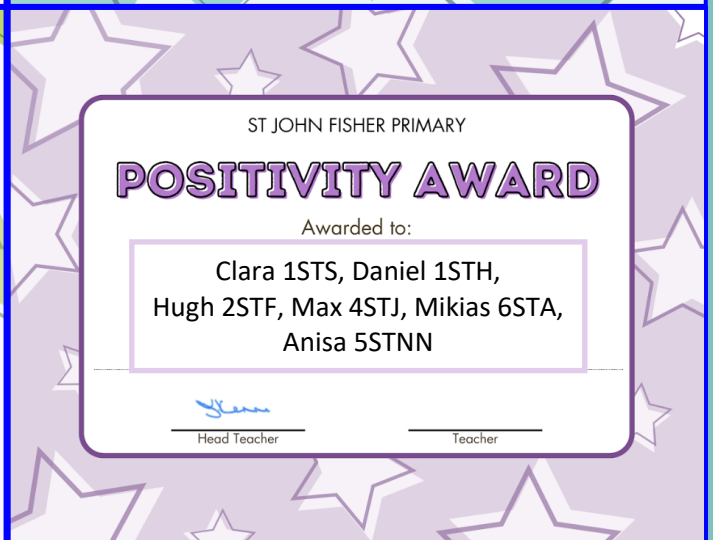
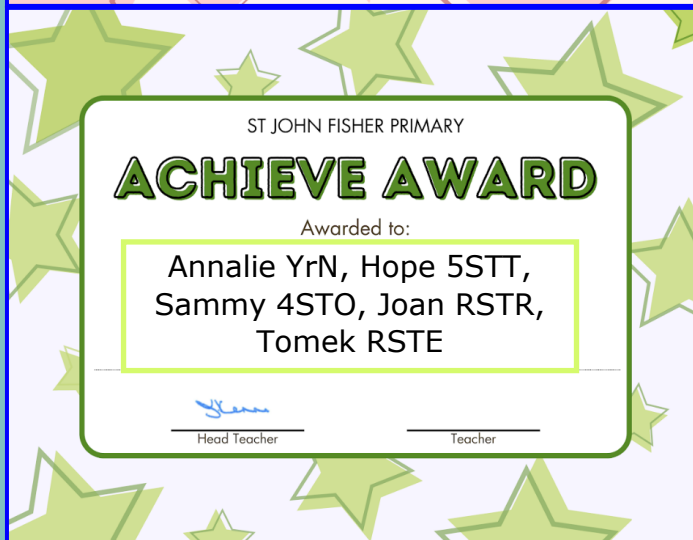
