



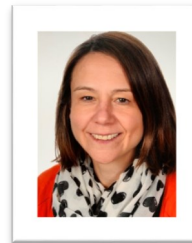

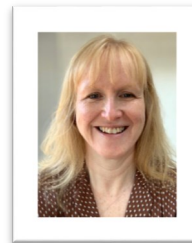

How will we keep you safe?

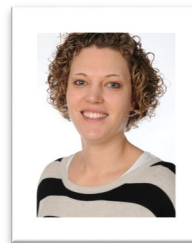

Who can you talk to?

If you are worried about something you can talk to an adult in school.
