KEY COASTAL COUNTIES AND REGIONS NORTH WEST ENGLAND

CUMBRIA	LANCASHIRE
Features a rugged coastline, part of the Lake District, the Solway Firth and stretches from Morecambe Bay up to the Scottish border.	Known for traditional seaside resorts including Blackpool, Cleveleys, Fleetwood and St Anne's.
MERSEYSIDE	CHESHIRE
Features the industrial Mersey waterfront, the historic city of Liverpool, and popular beaches like Crosby and Formby.	Contains the northern part of the Wirral Peninsula, which offers sandy beaches and coastal walks
