Year 1 Clitheroe Castle

Dear Parent/Carer,

As part of this term's topic on Castles, children from year 1 will be visiting Clitheroe Castle, on **Thursday 2nd May**.

Clitheroe Castle is a ruined early medieval castle in Clitheroe in Lancashire. It was the caput of the Honour of Clitheroe, a vast estate stretching along the western side of the Pennines. Its earliest history is debated but it is thought to be of Norman origin, probably built in the twelfth century. Children will explore the castle in the morning learning about Castles & Keeps. The afternoon will be taken up with stories about Dragons & Dungeons.

Children must be in school on time as the mini-buses will be leaving promptly at 9.15am; we will return to school at approximately 2.30pm. **Uniform t-shirt and Jumper must be worn**, good walking footwear trainers or walking shoes, jeans or jogging bottoms. If your child suffers from travel sickness, please could you send in a named envelope a tablet for the return journey.
