As a part of your child's education at St John's, we promote personal wellbeing and development through a comprehensive Personal, Social, Health and Economic (PSHE) education programme. PSHE education is the curriculum subject that gives children the knowledge, understanding, attitudes and practical skills to live safe, healthy, productive lives and meet their full potential.

I am writing to let you know that, during the year, your child will be taking part in lessons which will focus on the relationships and sex education (RSE) aspect of this programme.

Lessons in each year group will include pupils learning about: Healthy relationships, including friendships; families; growing and changing, including being healthy, changing feelings; becoming more independent; keeping safe; developing self-esteem and confidence. Pupils will also have opportunities to ask questions. All lessons will be taught with age appropriate materials and at a level that is appropriate to their developmental stage.
