As part of this terms topic on 'Romans' class 4 will be visiting the Roman Museum at Ribchester, near Preston on **Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> March**. The museum contains many artefacts charting the history of this beautiful and historic part of Lancashire, from Neolithic to Roman times and beyond. It has one of the most educational and interesting Roman displays in the northwest and a collection of Roman artefacts unrivalled in Lancashire.

The day will include an introductory talk, object handling, dressing up in Roman armour, a visit to the remains of the fort and, of course, a look around the Museum.

We will be leaving school promptly at 9.15am; we expect to return to school at normal home time, but this will depend on traffic and could be slightly later. **(We will inform parents via Parent app if it is later than expected)**. If your child suffers from travel sickness, please could you send in a named envelope a tablet for the return journey.
