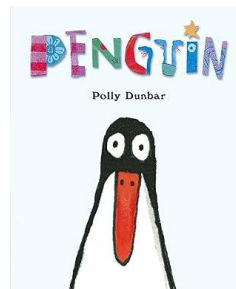
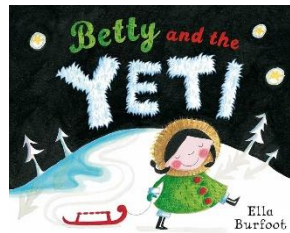
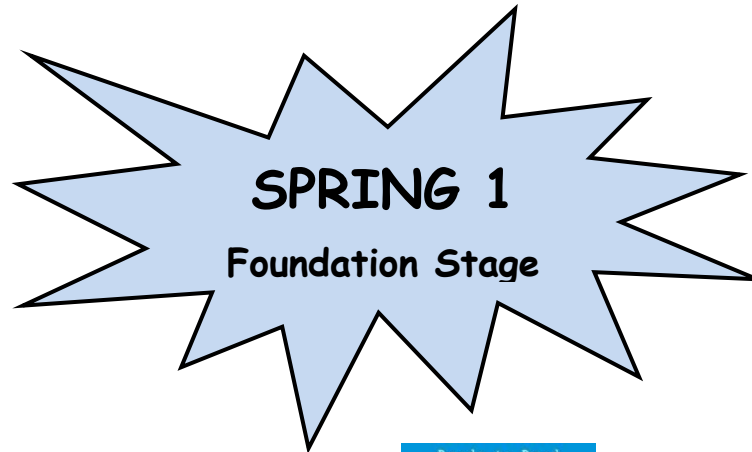
Talk about cold weather ~ snow, frost and ice and discuss changes in the weather and our local environment
