- Introduce vocabulary to enable children to talk about their observations and to ask questions e.g. road, town, promenade, seafront, pier
- Examine photographs and simple maps and visit local places
- Encourage children to express opinions on natural and built environments and give opportunities for them to hear different points of view on the quality of the environment
- Continue to develop an awareness of the changing seasons
