Bathing Machine

A small, wheeled wooden hut used on beaches in the 18th & 19th centuries. Allowing bathers to change into swimwear privately.

Shore

The land along the edge of a large body of water, such as an ocean, sea, or lake.

Holidays

A time or day where normal work is paused for rest, recreation or celebration.

Resort

A self-contained, commercial destination designed for relaxation and recreation.

Promenade

A leisurely walk taken in a public space, or a wide, paved pathway. Such as a seaside boardwalk, riverfront, or plaza, designed explicitly for walking and taking in the scenery.

Popular

Something that is widely liked, enjoyed or admired by a large number of people.

Victorian

The reign of Queen Victoria of the United Kingdom (1837 - 1901).

Seaside

The land bordering the sea or ocean, particularly coastal area developed for leisure and tourism.
