Year 3 - Summer 2

Learning Question: Which significant people from Blackpool should be given a blue plaque and why? How did they improve and 'grow' Blackpool as a town today?

Writing Outcomes - Persuasive writing:

<u>Science - Nutrition</u>

Children will be able to name the nutrients found in food and state that to be healthy we need to eat the right types of food to give us the correct amount of these nutrients.

They will also look at how food is produced and where it comes from.

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<u>History</u>

What can we find out about the history of Blackpool?

During this topic children will learn about what life was like in Blackpool in the past and compare with daily life in Blackpool today. They will research the school's own history.

The children will find out about local significant people who 'built' Blackpool and still remembered and significant today. They will find out how and why blue plaques are awarded and name some local places and people who have been awarded a blue plaque.
