

Year 6 Newsletter Spring 2026

During our first half term we will be focussing on the tale of Macbeth. We will look at pieces of Shakespeare's work and will write descriptively and also a persuasive argument based on these texts. In the second half term our focus text will be Wonder. We will read the text and base all of our English work around this.

Maths

During our maths lessons we will be following the White Rose curriculum and will be focusing on our fluency and reasoning. We will be competing the topics of fractions, decimals, percentages, ratio and algebra.

Adventurous Afternoons

Science – we will be completing the topics of electricity and evolution and inheritance.

Geography - in geography we will be investigating our town – we will then compare this with a beach study on our trip to Wales.

History – our topic for the first half term will be the Elizabethan era which will link in with our English books from Shakespeare.

ICT – during our ICT lessons we will be spreadsheets and creating text adventures.

Music – we will be focusing on the skill of performance. Our topic will be Roots which has an African music theme.

PSHE – our PSHE lessons are really important this year as we encounter a lot of change. Our first topic is internet safety and online relations leading onto our second topic of being safe and people who care for me.
