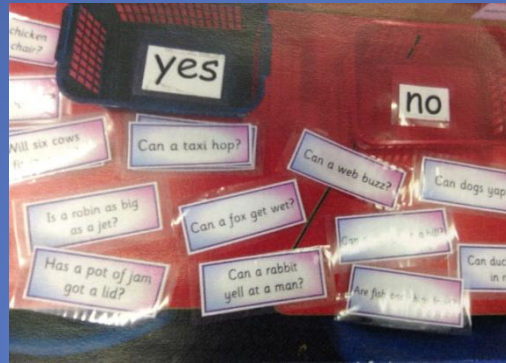

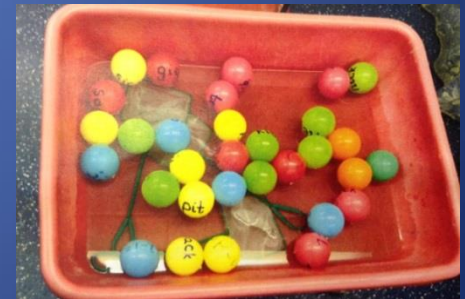
This incorporates:

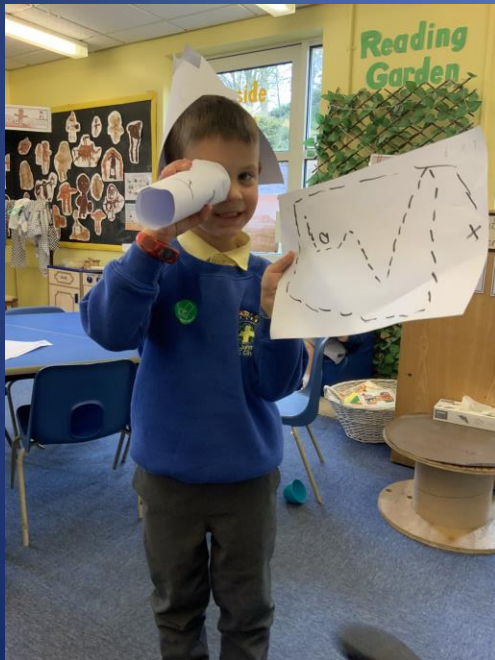
This includes:
