



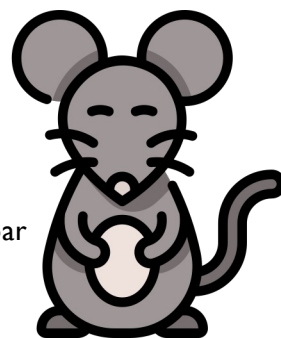
QUICK COMPREHENSION - THE LION & THE MOUSE

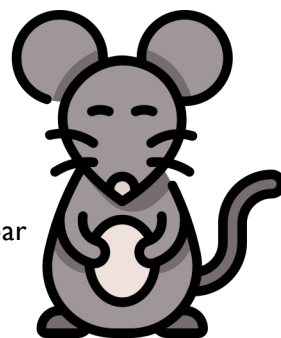
