

What are the aims and intentions of this curriculum?

In Year 10 students begin their study of the GCSE Curriculum. This still follows the 5 areas of the assessment framework: Genre, Narrative, Representation, Industry and Audience. Students will study the set texts for their examination, as well as unseen examples from the same genre. Students will be given their practical task in March which is 30% of the final grade.
