

Choose foods lower in fat, salt and sugars

Eat at least 5 portions of a variety of fruit and vegetables every day.



Eat less often and in small amounts

beans, pulses, fish, eggs, meat and other proteins
Eat more sourced fish and pulses. 2 portions of sustainably sourced fish per week, one of which is oily.
Eat less red and processed meat.



Choose wholegrain or higher fibre versions with less added fat, salt and sugar.



dairy, and alternatives
Choose lower fat and lower sugar options.



Water, lower fat milk, sugar-free drinks including tea and coffee all count.
Limit fruit juice and/or smoothies to a total of 150ml a day.




Choose unsaturated oils and use in small amounts.






