RE

We are following Come and See to deliver our RE curriculum.

We will be starting our half term learning about Judaism (Abraham, Moses and Shabbat) We will then be learning about Baptism and Advent during December.

Maths

This half-term, we are focusing on Place value and Shape.

Place Value

Partitioning into tens and ones Using number lines effectively to estimate Comparing numbers and sets of objects

<u>Shape</u>

Identifying and naming 2D and 3D shapes Counting sides and vertices of 2D shapes Counting faces, edges and vertices of 3D shapes

Making patterns with shapes

All children will be given login information for an app called 'Numbots' They should access Numbots at home at least twice a week to consolidate learning of maths and to support their maths skills.

More information on this, including their login information, will be shared at Parents Evening this week.

The children in Year 1 / 2 are working hard to develop routines and good learning behaviour. It has been a very busy first half-term and I'm sure that this half-term will be even busier! Here is

Science

what we will be learning over the half term....

This term in Science we are looking at Animals including Humans.

This will include carnivores, herbivores and omnivores, human bodies and the senses, animals and offspring, lifecycles and staying healthy.

<u>History</u>

We have been learning about the changes of monarchy and looking at the big question: How are the reigns of Queen Elizabeth I, Queen Victoria and Queen Elizabeth II the same or different? We will continue with History for another few weeks before starting our Geography unit before Christmas.

Geography

We will focus on the topic 'Where I live' during this Geography unit.

This begins with looking at Billingham and where the school is located before comparing this with schools and homes in Kenya.

We will be using TenTen Resources to support our PSHE curriculum.

We will then focus on some traditional tales including the Three Little Pigs.

During December, we will look at some more instructional writing to help us with our own instructions for Christmas crafts alongside reading and writing based on 'The Christmasaurus'.
