## Money

## Measuring length

Draw the following lines using a ruler. Try to be exact in your measurements.

1. 10cm
2. 12cm
3. 5cm
4. 9cm
5. 18cm
6.  $15 \frac{1}{2}$  cm

Draw 4 more lines and measure them accurately. Write their length next to the line.

## Simon Says

Play Simon says with your family (with a maths twist), e.g. Simon says, "Do 5 star jumps!"; Simon says, "Do 9 squats." Etc...

## 2D Shape Hunt

List the 2D shapes around your house, e.g. a window = rectangle; a plughole = circle. Can you talk about their properties using the correct names - sides and vertices (posh word for corners)?

## Money and Addition

When you go shopping, can you add up the cost of two of the items before you get to the checkout?

## Weighing & Measuring

Make a recipe with an adult. Ask that you weigh all the ingredients. (Be careful not to spill any on the floor.)

## Column addition

(Remember to use equipment to represent Tens and Ones - pencils and cubes or spaghetti and pasta shells.)

Ask parents to give you 5 calculations to try.

## 3D Shape Sort

Collect 3D shapes from around your home and sort them by their properties, e.g. number of edges/faces/vertices. See if you can group any together that have the same number of edges, etc.
