PE (Forest Theme)

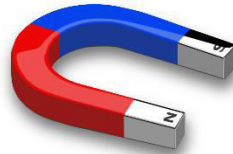

Read the story of Theseus and the Minotaur.

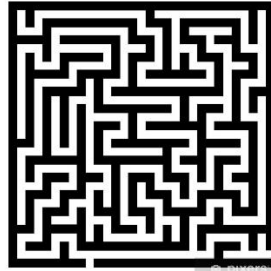
What lesson can be learnt from the story?

Family Timeline

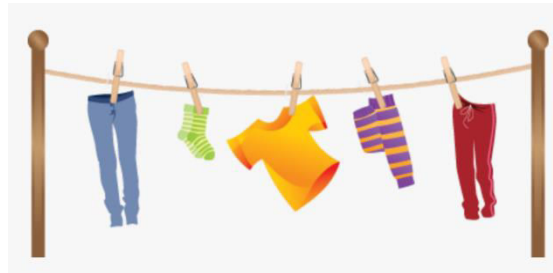
A timeline is a listing of events in chronological order.
