Information about eligibility for free school meals

If you receive any of the following support payments your child is entitled to receive free school meals, please complete the enclosed form and return to the address shown.

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999, or Child Tax Credit, as long as you are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have a yearly income (as assessed by HM Revenue & Customs) that is not more than £16,190 (this amount will change in 2011)
- Income-related employment and support allowance
- Guarantee part of Pension Credit

Young people who receive Income Support or income based Jobseeker's Allowance in their own right are also entitled to receive free school meals.

It should be noted that children who receive "education suitable for children who have not attained compulsory school age" will still need to satisfy the additional requirement of "receiving education both before and after the lunch period", being eligible to receive free school meals.

We will check your benefits using the free school meals checking service (ECS) provided by the Department for Education. If we can't find out about your benefits we will need to contact you before we can confirm your eligibility.

You must continue to pay for all your child's school meals until we receive proof that they are entitled to free school meals.

If you have children in secondary school and qualify for free school meals you will be entitled to a school clothing grant, please contact (01642) 526606 for more details.
