Some polite reminders:

**School dinners-**Please ensure if you are changing from dinners to packed lunches that you speak to Mrs Small. Meals are ordered in advance and have to be paid for - if you have not let us know, we may have to re-coup the cost from you. A quick phone call will avoid this happening.

**Nut Free-**We have been a nut free school for several years now as we have members of our school who have serious allergies. Please check that items in packed lunches/snacks do not have any type of nut listed as an ingredient. It is these items that could cause a problem.

**Jewellery-** Children should not were jewellery of any description for school, apart from a simple watch if desired. Any children with earing that cannot yet be removed must have them covered for school and once healed, removed. This is for Health and Safety reasons.

Make up - Children should not be wearing make-up/nail varnish for school.

**Home time**- We have re-opened the school yard for home time collection. Could we please request that adults collecting do not stand too close to the exit gate (Reception) or door (KS2) - there are 4 classes coming out of this exit and we need space for the children to stand safely whilst staff hand them over.

Please remain behind the white playground markings and staff will send your child/ren to you.

**Covid-** Unfortunately there are still a large number of cases being reported in the Stockton area. If your child has any potential symptoms, please have a test done before sending them into school. If anyone in your household tests positive, the children should remain at home in isolation too. We remain vigilant in school and children are washing/sanitising their hands regularly.
