

Nursery Mark Making Bingo

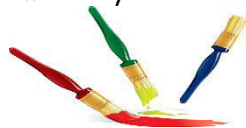

Keep safe, keep squiggling with your pencils, felt tips and crayons, keep using your imagination and keep making memories.

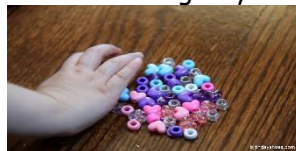
Love Miss Hearn x
