2. Read through 'The Zoo Vet' text and answer the questions on the first question sheet. If you want to be challenged you can answer the second sheet of questions, too! Write your answers in your green book. Grownups – I have included the answers so that you can see how well your child has scored.

3. Complete the 'a' and 'b' handwriting sheets. Take special care to write on the line and to form your letters starting in the correct place. You can keep practising to form these letters each day for 5 minutes in your green book.

4. Can you start to keep a diary? At the end of each week, write some sentences about all the things you have done this week. How have you felt? What did you enjoy doing the most, why? You can do this in your green book.
