Mental objective for the week: practise counting to 20

- Practise counting to 20 each day. Stand up and crouch down as you count. Talk about odd and even numbers like we do in nursery.

- Talk about the different sizes of the Billy Goats. How many words can you think of to describe big and small?
- Practise writing 3. Can you find: 3 pennies, 3 pens and 3 spoons. How many altogether? Talk about how there are 3 lots of 3.
- **Challenge** – if you had 4 lots of 3 how many would that be?

Understanding the World

Goats will eat anything from lovely green grass to scrubby weeds. They are browsers not grazers, that means they are not like cows and sheep. They are good at clearing rough and overgrown land. So, they do not just eat grass, they prefer to browse a wide variety. Goats are called ruminants- animals who eat plants and digest them in their stomach which has 4 compartments!
