

Activities from the list below are to be completed over a two-week period.

Communication and Literacy

1. Play I spy something beginning with a certain letter sound.
2. Choose your favourite story book. Ask your adult to read the story to you. Can you draw pictures of each character?
3. Can you make up a rhyming song? Ask your adult to help.

Understanding the World

1. Think about the community that are helping us in this difficult time. What job do they do? Do they wear a uniform? Draw a picture of them.
2. What is changing in your garden? Do you see anything new growing? Can you draw them?

Maths

1. Find a pair of shoes from each person in your house, hopefully they do not smell! Can you put them into the correct order from biggest to smallest? Who has the biggest feet?
2. Go for a walk with your grown up. Count how many rainbows you can see in the windows. How many did you see?

Physical

1. Are you eating healthy at home? Draw pictures of healthy food you have been eating. How many pieces of fruit or veg you should have each day?
2. Think of different animals you could move around like in your garden, for example, slither like a snake, hop like a frog.

Do not forget to keep practicing drawing and having a go at writing your name.
