### Science

As we are learning about Grace Darling, we are going to think about floating and sinking. Collect 5 to 10 items that can get wet like a stone, pencil, feather, sponge etc. Predict if each item will float or sink. Get a container of water, place each item into the water and see if it floats or sinks. Complete your table!

### History & Geography – The Seaside – Lighthouses

Grace Darling was a lighthouse keeper's daughter. She is famous in history for rescuing survivors from a shipwreck that happened in the night. Research Grace Darling and find out what happened on the night of the shipwreck. Create a leaflet about Grace with two facts about her. Make your leaflet as bright and colorful as you can.
