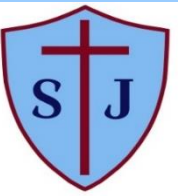

### English

Create a fact file about Lighthouses. Remember a fact file has a title, pictures, subheadings and lots of interesting facts.

You must include paragraphs about:

- What a lighthouse is
- What they are for
- The first ever lighthouse
- What are the different parts of a lighthouse.
- A picture with a caption

Think about using 2A sentences, conjunctions and questions.

### DT – Making a Lighthouse

1. **Design** – Design a model of a lighthouse and label the materials you need for each part.
2. **Make** – Following your design, make your model!
3. **Evaluate** – Look at your model and think about what has worked well and what would you change next time.

### Maths – Money & Coins

1. Draw and label the different coins that we have in England.

2. Make these amounts using coins:

12p, 27p, 35p, 49p, 56p, 64p, 71p, 87p, 99p

You could use real coins or draw them.

3. Draw or make a shop with different items that have different prices. Choose 2 items and work out the total. Pick another 2 items and work out the total. Repeat. Can you challenge yourself to pick 3 items and work out the total price?

4. Continue to practise key skills such as times tables and number bonds.
