Dear Year 1,

Welcome to the Summer term! We have lots of exciting things planned for this term, including our trip to the Locomotion. This term we have the Phonics Screening Check which will take place the week beginning 9th June. The children have worked incredibly hard throughout the year with their phonics and reading, and they should be very proud of themselves.

I just wanted to take the time to remind you about dates that are specific to us. Your PE days are **Wednesday** and **Friday**, this means you need to wear your **full PE tracksuit** (which consists of a plain black tracksuit or the school tracksuit with trainers).

Homework is shared on Seesaw every Monday. This will include spellings, maths and phonics activities. Short RWI practice videos are shared on SeeSaw weekly. Please ask if you don't have a login. Children can continue to use Numbots to support their maths skills and Phonics Play is a good, free website to help support your child's phonics skills. As well as this, children need to be reading their RWI books daily to an adult. Please make sure you record any reading as this will get the children golden reading tokens.
