A message from the NSPCC...

The Talk PANTS campaign supports professionals, parents and carers of children aged 3-11, to have simple and age-appropriate conversations, that can help them keep children safe from sexual abuse.

- · 1 in 3 children sexually abused by an adult did not tell someone at the time.
- · 90% of children who are abused, are abused by someone they know.

From P through to S, by sharing the Talk PANTS rules with a child, you can help them understand and remember some simple but vital messages: that their body belongs to them, they have a right to say no, and that they can speak to a trusted adult if they are worried or upset. Since we launched Talk PANTS in 2013, parents have had over 6 million conversations with their children about sexual abuse, but we know that many more still are not. We need to keep raising awareness to ensure more of these important conversations are happening...that is why we're holding our first Hartlepool and Stockton Talk PANTS week from 18th-29th November 2024. We will be visiting St. Joseph's on Monday 25th November 2024, the parents session is in the school hall at 2.30pm, we look forward to seeing you there.
