Dear Year 1,

Welcome to the summer term! We have lots of exciting things planned for this term. This term the Phonics Screening Check will take place the week beginning 10<sup>th</sup> June. The children have been working extremely hard throughout the year with their phonics and reading, and should be very proud of themselves.

I just wanted to take the time to remind you about dates that are specific to us. PE days are **Monday and Wednesday**, this means children will need to wear their **full PE tracksuit** (which consists of the school tracksuit with black trainers).

Weekly phonics homework is set on Seesaw on a Monday and must be completed by the following Monday. New spellings are also given on a Monday and set on Spelling Shed, these will be tested the following Monday. Topic grid homework is due on 5<sup>th</sup> July – children enjoy sharing their learning in class, please support your child to complete their homework. Children can continue to use Numbots to support their Maths skills and Phonics Play is a free useful website to support their phonics skills. In addition to this, children need to be reading their reading book (or part of the book) daily to an adult which needs to be recorded in your child's reading record. Year 1 will visit the school library on a Friday to choose a reading for pleasure book.

Parents, please continue to check the school's website for updates and the curriculum. Children's classroom learning is shared on Seesaw and weekly achievements are shared on Facebook.
