Draw on paper (or Purple Mash) what flavours and toppings would you have? Write a description using adjectives to describe.</li></ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Help an adult plant something in the garden.</li><li>• What plants do you eat? Make a list of plants you eat in a week.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Learn to tell the time to the hour and half hour on an analogue clock.</li><li>• Learn how to read and write numbers to 100 – practise counting forwards and backwards.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Go on a trip to a local beach – you could take photos and write about where you went and what you did there.</li><li>• Have you been to a beach that is not in the local area?</li></ul>

Please ensure that the 'Non-Negotiable' homework is regularly completed and then complete at least 1 bullet point from each subject area. The children can present their homework in a variety of ways- in their Homework book, by sending photos/evidence via SeeSaw or bringing in to school any evidence that they have completed the task. Children will be rewarded with Dojo points for completing their homework. Spellings are updated on Spelling Shed once a test has been completed. Homework will be shared as a class and celebrated.
