Dear Parents/Carers,

It is lovely to see how well our youngest children have settled into school and we invite parents to join us next week for our welcome to school.

Class News — Y6 Year 6 have made an excellent start to their new school year. Within the first two weeks back, the children have written letters of application for the role that they wish to be allocated throughout their last year and have also attended their interviews with Mrs Hargreaves and Mr Tindall. The children have begun to describe New York City within our first lessons of King Kong as part of their writing. Within Maths, Year 6 have begun to understand the place value of numbers within 10 million. Changing Power of the Monarchy is their history topic and they have already looked at William the Conqueror and King John and the Magna Carta. Within Science, Year 6 have grouped and classified animals, plants and insects. They have had a lot of fun throughout all lessons and have enjoyed their Rugby lessons in P.E. Well done for a fantastic start!

Class News - Y4/5 Welcome Back! It's amazing to see every child excitedly coming to their new Y4/5 class with enthusiasm and ready to take on new learning challenges. They have settled extremely well into the new systems and routines of the day. We are looking forward to a very positive year. Things to remember! The class will have PE on Wednesday and Friday, so children will need to bring their PE kit into school on Monday. The PE kit should include a plain yellow T-shirt, black shorts, and PE shoes. The children can also bring tracksuit bottoms/ black leggings for outside activities. All clothes should be labelled and kept in a bag in their locker. Children can take it back on Friday after school to wash. Homework will be given out on a Friday and must be back in school on Wednesday. Children are not allowed to wear earrings in school. Children in Y4/5 are expected to read at least five times a week at home. This should be recorded in their Home Reading Record by the adult who read with them.

Class News - Year 3 / 4 Welcome back to school – I hope everyone enjoyed the Summer Holidays. The children have settled in well and are beginning to learn the new routines. This half term in Maths, we are learning about place value and addition and subtraction. In English, we have started our new reader about inspirational children around the world. The children will be learning about Ancient Civilisations with Miss Robbins (our HLTA in History) and in RE, we have started to learn about Jesus' family. Please remember to ensure your child brings their reading book and reading record into school, every day.

Class News — Year 1/2 Year 1 & 2 have had a brilliant start to the year and have settled in very well. In English, we have been reading 'The Three Billy Goats Gruff' and writing some super sentences. In RE, we have started our first topic all about 'New Beginnings' and talked about God's creation. In Science, we have started our new topic 'Animals Including Humans' and in History we have started our new topic all about 'Toys in the Past'. Y1 & 2 have made me very proud following all of the class rules and being superstars. Well done everyone let's keep it up!

**Class News – EYFS** The Reception children have had a great start to the year and have settled in very well. We have started our topic for this term, Goldilocks and the three bears, we have read the story and the children have been acting it out. In RE, we have started our first topic all about 'Myself' and talked about the importance of our names. The children have enjoyed finding their names, writing them and painting their own portraits. They have made an excellent start to the year. Well done everyone!



#### The School Day

The children need to be in school by 8:40am so that they are ready and in class to start the school day by 8.50am. The gates to the playground are locked at 8:45am. We would ask that the children do not play on the field or equipment before school, if it has rained the children will end up being wet and muddy for the day.

You will appreciate that we have procedures in place to keep the children safe in school and as they leave the building. If you are not able to pick your child up the school needs to hold details of who is collecting the child, their details and a safe word. Please return the form that has been sent separately.

#### **Attendance**

We appreciate that from time to time that children are ill but attendance at school is really important. Attached is an overview of some of the guidance regarding illness.

Rashes and	
skin infections	Recommended period to be kept away from school, nursery or childminders
Athlete's foot	None
Chickenpox*	Until all vesicles have crusted over
Cold sores, (Herpes simplex)	None
German measles (rubella)*	Four days from onset of rash (as per "Green Book")
Hand, foot and mouth	None
Impetigo	Until lesions are crusted and healed, or 48 hours after commencing antibiotic treatment
Measles*	Four days from onset of rash
Molluscum contagiosum	None
Ringworm	Exclusion not usually required
Roseola (infantum)	None
Scabies	Child can return after first treatment
Scarlet fever*	Child can return 24 hours after commencing appropriate antibiotic treatment
Slapped cheek (fifth disease or parvovirus B19)	None once rash has developed
Shingles	Exclude only if rash is weeping and cannot be covered
Warts and verrucae	None
Diarrhoea and	December 1
vomiting illness	Recommended period to be kept away from school, nursery or childminders
Diarrhoea and/or vomiting	48 hours from last episode of diarrhoea or vomiting

#### All uniform MUST be labelled

School policy is that the children should <u>not</u> wear earring. All long hair should be tied up. PE is on a Friday – PE kits needed in school (yellow t shirt, back shorts, black plimsols). We ask that children wear the correct school uniform and sensible shoes.
