	<u>Autumn Term</u>	<u>Spring Term</u>	<u>Summer Term</u>
Nursery	- In nursery we teach phase 1 phonics in Autumn term. - Phase 1 covers the 7 aspects of early reading - These are environmental, instrumental, body sounds, rhythm and rhyme, alliteration, voice sounds and oral blending and segmenting.	Children are assessed and some will then start RWI nursery phonics.	The letter sounds covered in nursery are m,a,s,d,t,i,n,,p,g,o,c,k,u,b,f,e, and l.
Reception	- All children will start on RWI set 1 phonics covering the letter sounds m,a,s,d,t,i,n,,p,g,o,c,k,u,b,f,e,l, sh, h, r, j, v, w, x, y, z, th, ch, qu, ng, nk. - Children will be taught to orally blend and segment using 'fred talk'. - All children are assessed at the end of Autumn term. - Any children able to recognise the vast majority of sounds and be able to orally blend will move onto RWI set 2 sounds.	- In Spring term the children will be taught RWI set 2 sounds: 'special friends' ay, ee, igh, ow, oo, oo, ir, ou, ar, oy air, or. - Also the children will be taught the additional sounds ph, wh, ck, kn	In Summer term continue to teach and reinforce set 2 sounds. By the end of Reception all children should know set 1 and set 2 sounds and be able to confidently read RWI green level reading books. All children will be assessed and grouped ready for Year 1.
Year 1	- There will be 4 phonics groups in Year 1. - Children who need to recap and consolidate Set 1/Set2 sounds before moving to Set3 'special friends' ea, oi, aw, ur, er, ai, oa, are, ow, ire, ear, ure. - 'chatty friends' a-e, i-e, o-e, u-e.	Children will be assessed using the Year 1 phonics screening test and moved within the groups accordingly. The children will complete the Year 1 phonics screening test in June.	By the end of Year 1 children will be able to recognise and use all phonic sounds. Children assessed as working at the expected level should be confidently reading and answering questions on a RWI blue level book.
