Our final 'Stay & Pray Worship' this half term will take place at 9.05am- 9:10am on Tuesday 19th May for Class 1 and Little Joey's.

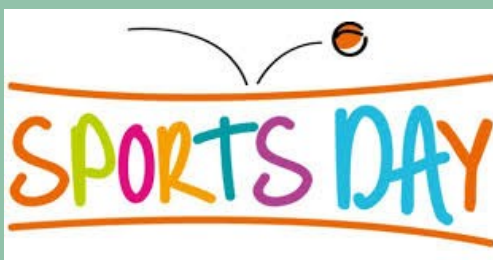

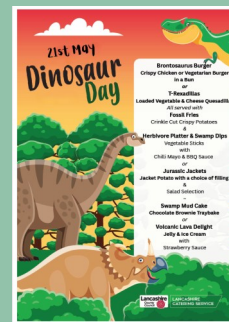
Sports Day
