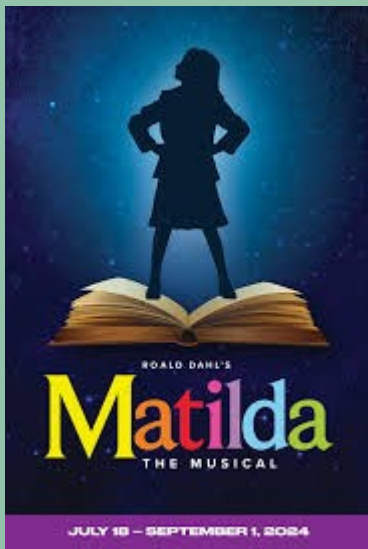
### St Peter and St Paul Worship

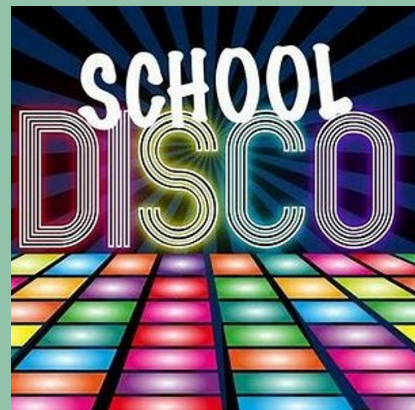
### Disco
