
If you wish to have your child Baptised here at St Joseph's church, please ring the Parish Office to book a place at the next Baptism Meeting.

Assisted Suicide Legislation - update

The important vote for all MPs on the assisted suicide legislation, known as the Terminally III Adults (End of Life) Bill, is likely to take place on 25th April.

N.B The Vote is now taking place on the 16th May 2025

The charity Right to Life UK has a simple online mechanism to allow people to contact their Member of Parliament and it only takes a few moments to submit a message to ask an MP to stop assisted suicide being rushed into law. It can be accessed here: https://righttolife.org.uk/asvote. Also, to let you know, Right to Life is distributing postcards to parishes for the lay faithful to send to their MPs on this subject.
