

## ST JOSEPH CATHOLIC PRIMARY SCHOOL CREATIVE CURRICULUM EYFS

Our EYFS Curriculum is planned within the Statutory Framework for the Early Years Foundation Stage, which leads into the KS1 National Curriculum in a way, which is meaningful and relevant for all children. The EYFS framework is organised into the following seven areas of learning. These shape the educational programme, and all are important and inter-connect.

## The three Prime areas

The three Prime areas in the EYFS are;

- Personal, social and emotional development
- Communication and language
- Physical development

These areas are fundamental in a child's life and if they are not achieved then the further four specific areas cannot be developed efficiently. These three areas are seen as essential 'building blocks' for securing these positive outcomes for young children in later life and into adulthood.

## The four Specific areas

The four Specific areas in the EYFS are;

- Literacy
- Mathematics
- Expressive art and design
- Understanding the world

At St Joseph's we are working towards children achieving the Early Goals by the end of the Reception year. To make progress towards the Early Learning Goals and to help identify children's developing knowledge, skills, understanding and attitudes school uses the 'Development Matters' document. We use a mixture of 'In the Moment' planning and topic based planning depending on the needs and the interests of the children.
