




## **Home Learning**

- This is done by setting a mixture of child initiated and set work to complete each week
- The children at home complete the same activities as the child in school
- Without forgetting about the fundamental values of the Early Years Foundation Stage – Learning through play




Children's work is set on our learning platform ClassDojo. Teachers can set work and children respond by uploading their work using photographs, videos, worksheets and the paint app on Dojo. We then can give feedback to support parents and children.









In the EYFS, staff upload daily phonics lessons and other videos to help parents to support their children at home with Phonics as well as Reading, Writing, Maths and Topic work. It is all very interactive with lots of videos of our EYFS staff.


## Portfolio

And now playing Fast Phonics - Mummy says you were right and I am LOVING it so happy flappy






The children can then complete the tasks at home with the help from the teacher in school and parental support.



All topic based work is set and submitted in the same way and teachers can see and make comments on all of the fantastic work children do at home.








Work that children complete in class is also shared on ClassDojo so everyone can see their friends and know that everyone is doing the same work.
