Who should I contact to discuss the concerns or needs of my child?	
Class teacher	<ul> <li>He/she is responsible for:         <ul> <li>Adapting and refining the curriculum to respond to strengths and needs of all pupils. Checking on the progress of your child, identifying, planning and delivery of any additional support;</li> <li>Contributing to devising personalised learning plans to prioritise and focus on the next steps required for your child to improve learning.</li> <li>Applying the school's SEND policy.</li> </ul> </li> <li>If you have concerns about your child, you should speak to your child's class teacher first. You may then be directed to the SENCO.</li> </ul>
Special Educational Needs Coordinator (SENCO): MRS M BAXENDALE  Email: school.info@st-josephs- wrightington.lancs.sch.uk	Is responsible for:  Coordinating provision for children with SEND and developing and following the school's SEND policy;  Liaising with a range of agencies outside of school who can offer advice and support to help pupils overcome any difficulties;  Providing specialist advice and facilitating training to ensure that all staff are skilled and confident about meeting a range of needs;  Ensuring that parents are:  Involved in supporting their child's learning and access;  Kept informed about the range and level of support offered to their child;  Included in reviewing how their child is doing;  Consulted about planning successful movement (transition) to a new class or school.
Head teacher (also the SENCO at St Joseph's): MRS M BAXENDALE	<ul> <li>Is responsible for:</li> <li>The day to day management of all aspects of the school, including the provision made for pupils with SEND</li> </ul>
SEN Governor: MR A SCOTT	Is responsible for:  • Supporting school to evaluate and develop quality and impact of provision for pupils with SEND across the school.
