Using Portfolios on Class Dojo




What are they?

Portfolios are a great way for parents and children to show off their work and share it with their teachers.

Teachers might set work or 'activities' and students can respond, but children can also share something they are proud of and want their teacher to see (Yes, I 100% want to see the most incredible Lego creations, even if it isn't a weekly Learning Project!

Don't worry about the wrong thing being posted, teachers must approve each portfolio submission first, they can even send it back to the child with tips on how to improve, or comment on it too!



To show you, I have attached myself to my niece and nephew's Dojo account - so apologies to them in advance!

As you can see I have a Teacher account, but now a 'Parent account' (from the code I typed in - you all have done this already) and a student account for George.



To see your available accounts, click the icon in the top left hand corner.

I am currently on George's student account, but will make a new account for Evie for the purposes of this.

First I click the icon and select my parent account.

(SOME OF YOU WILL SKIP THIS STEP AS YOUR ALREADY HAVE ACCOUNTS SET UP)



I have now messaged all Year 1 parents to let you know which speed sounds set your child is working on.

N.B. If your child is very secure with Set 1, please feel free to tune into Set 2 instead and the same with Set 2 moving on to Set 3.

Set 1 Speed Sounds at 9.30 am and again at 12.30 pm

Set 2 Speed Sounds at 10.00 am and again at 1.00 pm

Set 3 Speed Sounds at 10.30 am and again at 1.30 pm


Note: films are streamed live and won't be available at other times.







How it works I want to add a new child (you don't need to do this if you already have one child set up)



I want to add a child using a code - this is the code that you have been sent on the letter last week.

Without the code, you cannot access your child's account.

You have likely already done this.

You're now part of Evie's classroom community. Stay tuned for posts and announcements from their teacher.








How it works


I have used the code to connect with Evie's account.

If I click on her Dojo character I can edit it, look at points history etc.

This does not allow me to post things to her portfolio.



On Evie's individual page I can see what rewards she has had, or edit her character - but this <u>does</u>
not allow me to affect her portfolio.



As you can see, my accounts list (see slide 3) now shows both George and Evie's accounts.


If I tap on to Evie's
Account, it gives me access
to Evie's personal Dojo
account, rather than the
parental side of it.




This is Evie's personal Dojo page.

As you can see, at the moment, there are 'No activities' set. This section would be different later in the week if the class teacher had set activities through Class Dojo.

If we tap it, it takes us to the next page anyway, giving us the opportunity to upload to Evie's portfolio.



We then would click on the + symbol next to the Completed section, where a list of set activities may be in the future.



This then gives you the option of what sort of entry might go into the portfolio,

Journal

This might simply be a short diary entry of your day, explaining what you have been up to!

Photo/Video

Take a photo or video of something and show your teacher!

Drawing

You can draw a picture of something you did to upload!



I decided to upload a photograph to show a picture of what we might have been learning about

(Yes, that is 2 Stormtroopers dancing, of course they are made from Lego)





Now I have taken my photo, I need to explain what it is about.


I can either type something in the top box, or another idea if to hold the record button (if you have a microphone) and explain in your own words what your image is of.

How it works

When I have explained what my image is about, I click the send button to send it to my portfolio.

The class teacher gets a notification and has to approve it before it goes live.

They might send a comment back to tell me how brilliant I am, or ask for more information before it is uploaded fully!
