ARCHDIOCESAN LEVY FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2023-2024

'The Archdiocese operates a school building fund to help meet the costs of all capital works i.e. investment in the building fabric over a value of £2000.

Parishes and schools contribute equally to the fund and the school share provides the opportunity for all parents of children who benefit from the facilities to contribute. The school share is based upon an annual amount calculated at £10 per family. Whilst the decision regarding the raising of this levy is a local one, the majority of schools request a voluntary contribution from parents on this basis.'
