### **YEAR 3/4/5 TRIP TO MANCHESTER SCIENCE AND INDUSTRY MUSEUM**

Dear Parents/Carers,

We have arranged to take the pupils in Years 3, 4 and 5 to Manchester Science and Industry Museum on **Monday 17th June 2024**.

Throughout the day, we will be taking part in planned workshops and an action packed day of activities. These workshops will link to our Science, Sport and Art curriculum. Pupils will be grouped for workshops to ensure that the content is directed at the specific objectives of the relevant curriculum (KS2). The day should be enriching and enjoyable for all.

Pupils should come to school at the usual time, wearing full school uniform. The coach will depart at 9.15 a.m. and return to school before 3.30pm.

Pupils will need a **light** packed lunch, including drink (**NO CANS/GLASS BOTTLES OR FLASKS**). This can be ordered from school or alternatively pupils may bring one from home. Packed lunches brought from home should be in a plastic bag rather than a lunchbox so that **ALL** packaging can be disposed of in the litter bin and not carried around for the rest of the afternoon.

Pupils are able to bring up to £5 spending money as they will be able to visit the giftshop on this occasion.

To cover the cost of the coach travel we are asking for a contribution of £11.00 per child. Unfortunately, if insufficient voluntary contributions are received, the trip will not go ahead.
