Something to improve on

Things that you felt that we could improve on and what we have done so far to address them.

You said that we could **improve our communication about events and give more notice**. So we have:

- Introduced a 'Save the Date' half termly events calendar
- Given more notice of upcoming events on our Newsletter
- Ensured that the Newsletter has more relevant information
- Regular updates about news and information on Dojo
- Sent more text reminders

You said that we could **provide more extra-curricular sports and equipment**. So we have:

- Bought a range of equipment for the children to use at playtimes
- Introduced football training for the Year 5 and 6 children with Mr Wolohan, who is a qualified football coach, with matches to be arranged
- Signed up for a range of different sporting events for the children to participate in such as;
 - Year 3 and Year 4 Dodgeball
 - Year 1 and Year 2 Football
 - Year 5 and year 6 Dodgeball
 - Year 3 and Year 4 Park Run
 - Year 5 and Year 6 Netball

You said that we could **harness more parental skills via a volunteer group**. So we have:

- Shared flyers on Dojo from our parent volunteer group 'Friends of St Josephs' with information on how to get involved
