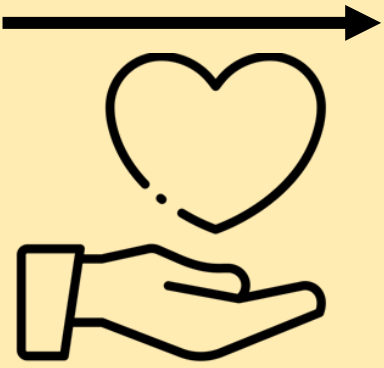


Jesus taught us about God's love for us.



Jesus served everyone and he shows us how to be Christian leaders by being helpful and loving to others.

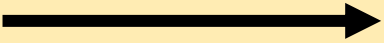

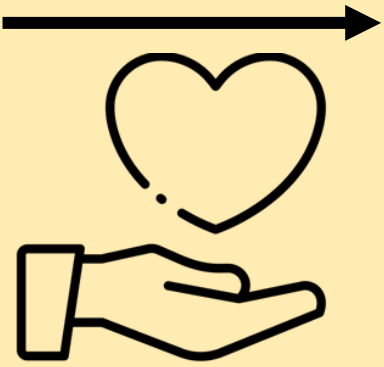


There in the garden of tears

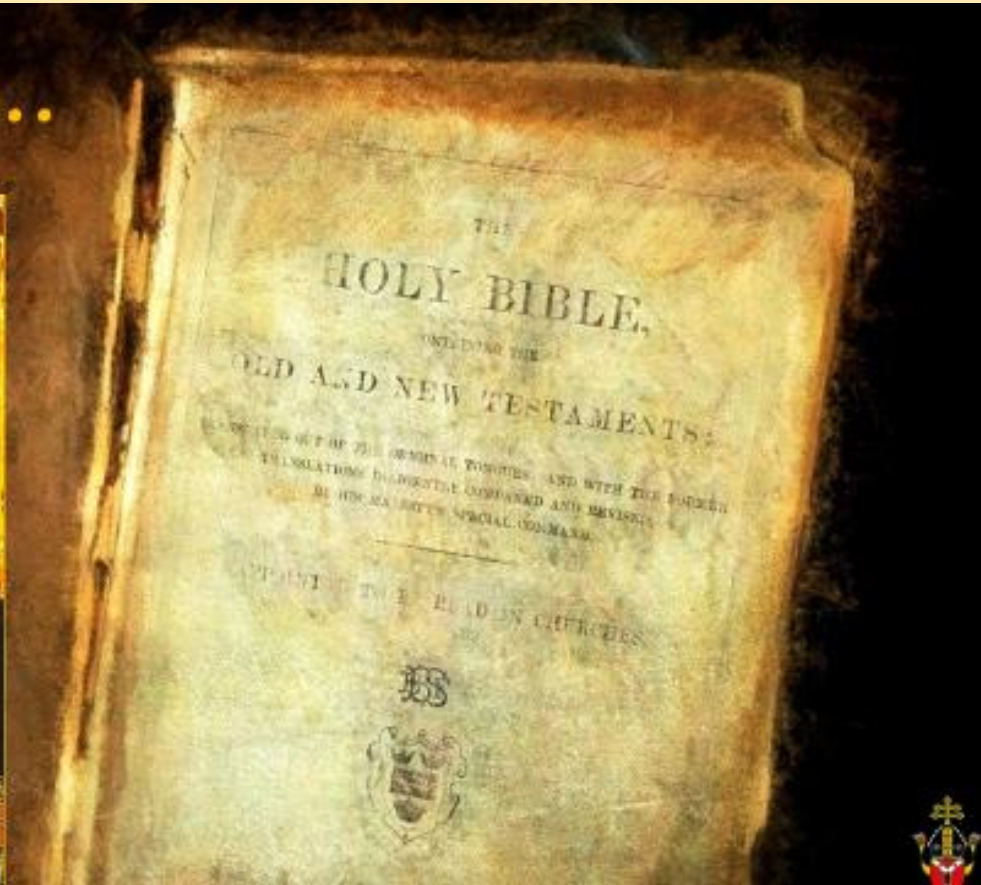
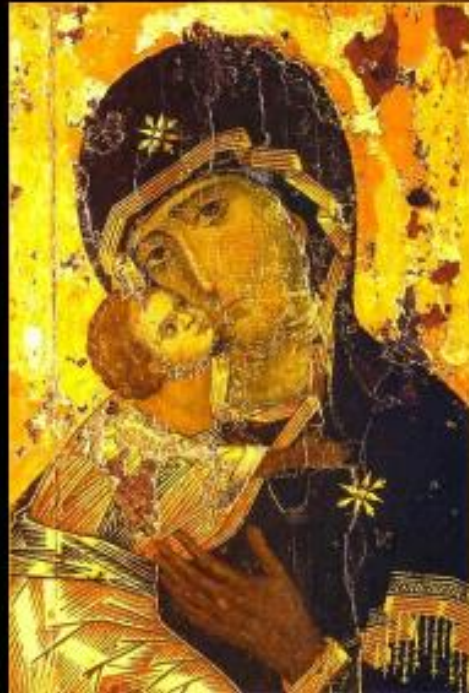
So let us learn how to serve
