2a	Return to School – Staffing, pupil numbers, H&S	
	<ul> <li>Headteacher reported: <ul> <li>All year groups have settled well.</li> <li>On the first day of term there were issues with gate timings, an extra 5 minutes has been added giving parents 10 minutes from 8.35am to 8.45am.</li> <li>Headteacher reported on pupil numbers; roughly 40 places down, equating to £140k in terms of funding. Ealing have predicted a further slump in pupil numbers and Reception numbers are likely to lower again next year. Reducing PAN will make a difference.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	
	Governor asked what we are doing, as a school, to attract pupils. The Headteacher said we have frequent parent tours, brochures, advertising in the parish newsletters etc.	
	Governor commented there is the perception that you must be a catholic to come to a catholic school; we need to let families know that you can get your child into a catholic school if you are non-catholic. Other faiths may prefer a catholic School.	
	Governors discussed ideas for increasing pupil numbers:  - Flyers for the local area  - Let parents know there are in-year admissions places available.  - Advertise on community website such as Ealing and Northfields Friends.	
	<ul> <li>Posters in children's centres, nurseries, playgroups etc – with an 'everyone is welcome' message.</li> </ul>	



	<ul> <li>Send information to other parishes letting them know we have available spaces.</li> <li>Headteacher speak at other churches.</li> <li>Twitter and Facebook accounts to promote the school.</li> <li>Brochure display at the back of Our Lady and St Joseph's Church.</li> <li>Advertise at Ealing Hospital</li> <li>Governor said we must retain the Catholic pupils we have and not over dilute our Catholicity, this is an opportunity to share the gift of our faith to other faiths, or those with no faith.</li> <li>Headteacher reported staff have been devastated by the death of a staff member. Assemblies were held for children; children were respectful and prayerful.</li> <li>Headteacher reported the 4 Early Careers Teachers (ECT) have settled in well and all are signed onto the 2-year ECT programme to further their knowledge.</li> <li>Headteacher reported the work on the Nursery roof overran by 2 weeks. The roof is not finished; builders are coming back during the half term to complete.</li> <li>Headteacher reported newly installed heating in the halls will be tested during the half term.</li> <li>Headteacher reported fire drills will take place after Year 6 return from the school journey.</li> </ul>	НТ

	The Headteacher said we must complete due diligence to find out if we are viable for academisation.

4d	Buildings Update	
	The Headteacher updated Governors on the building work, as follows:	
	<ul> <li>Work completed on the central heading in the main building. Heating to be tested during the half term.</li> <li>Nursery work over ran, scaffolding was not put up on time, a small amount of asbestos was found but it was completely sealed and not an issue, a professional company came in to remove the asbestos.</li> <li>Flat roof in the Nursery was not repaired and recently leaked during heavy rain. DHP will repair.</li> <li>Work on ACO channels by the Middle Phase will be completed by DHP during the half term, there were not enough installed leading to flooding.</li> </ul>	
	Governor asked about the damp grievance. No update, Headteacher will follow up with Ealing and report back.	
	Governor asked about school meals. The Headteacher said there were some problems in the first few days, catering staff need to check-in every child that takes a school meal, and this was taking a long time. The school office now prints off a register for each classroom and the teacher ticks children who are absent or have a packed lunch.	
	The quality of school lunches was discussed. The Headteacher said the food quality is fine, children choose not to take all the options available.	
	Governors talked about small food portions. The Headteacher agreed to monitor the portion sizes at lunchtime.	
	Governor asked about school pick-up times and if they are working. The Headteacher said children come out at 3.15 and the school gates close at 3.25pm. There have been no complaints.	
	Governor requested reviewing attendance at the next GB meeting. The Headteacher agreed.	
	Governor requested a teacher giving a curriculum presentation at the next GB meeting. The Headteacher agreed.
