#### Face coverings

#### **Entry routine request**

Please say your 'farewells', check for water bottles, packed lunch boxes before you get to the entry gate so that your child can get in as quickly as possible and not hold up other children.



#### Secondary Transfer meetings

There will be another opportunity to attend our Secondary School Transfer meeting at 7pm Friday 18<sup>th</sup> September. No more than 45 adults (no children) will be allowed to comply with social distancing regulations. **Temperature checks will be taken on entry and face coverings are mandatory – No covering, no entry, no exceptions** (except exemptions). Track and trace details will be held for 21 days after meetings. #### In the event...

In the event that your child wakes up with a fever (>37.8°C), or a new, continuous cough or a loss of the sense of smell or taste do not send them to school. Immediately book your child in for a test and the whole household has to isolate for 14 days. If the child tests positive, they have to stay off school for 10 days. If the test is negative, the child can return to school and the household no longer needs to self-isolate.

If your child has a sniffle, runny nose, sore throat or is sneezing, they are not coronavirus symptoms and your child should come to school if they are well enough.
